RFP for Construction of Two Lane with Paved Shoulder from “Design Km 45+325 (Ex Km 48+870) near Basinda Village to Design Km 90+010 (Ex Km 97+903) near Roshni Village section of NH-347B of Betul - Khandwa Package 2 in the State of Madhya on Hybrid Annuity Mode.

The Government of India had entrusted to the Authority the development, maintenance and management of National Highway No. 347B including the section from Design Km 45+325 (Ex Km 48+870) near Basinda Village to Design Km 90+010 (Ex Km 97+903) near Roshni Village section of NH-347B of Betul - Khandwa Package 2 (approx. 44.57 Km). The Authority had resolved to Construction of Two Lane with Paved Shoulder from “Design Km 45+325 (Ex Km 48+870) near Basinda Village to Design Km 90+010 (Ex Km 97+903) near Roshni Village section of NH-347B of Betul - Khandwa Package 2 in the State of Madhya by Two Laning thereof (the “Project”) on design, build, operate and transfer (the “Hybrid Annuity”) basis, and has decided to carry out the bidding process for selection of a private entity as the Bidder to whom the Project may be awarded. Technical submissions of the Bids received online shall be opened on 03.04.2025 (at 1130 hours IST).

Bid submitted through any other mode shall not be entertained. However, Bid Security, Power of Attorney for signing of the Bid, Power of Attorney for lead member of Consortium, if any, Joint Bidding Agreement for Consortium, if any, Integrity Pact, and experience certificates apostile at foreign origin, if any, and other documents required as per Clause 2.11.2 of RFP shall be submitted physically in original by the lowest Bidder before issuance of Letter of Award (LOA) by the Authority. **However, while submitting Bid Security via Account Payee demand draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt or Banker’s cheque, it is to be ensured by the Bidder that Account Payee demand draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt or Banker’s cheque are submitted physically latest within 5-working days of the Bid Due Date (upto 11:00 hours).** Please note that the Authority reserves the right to accept or reject all or any of the BIDs without assigning any reason whatsoever.



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
