However, Bid Security, POA for signing the Bid, POA for lead member of JV, if any, JBA for JV, if any, Integrity Pact, and experience certificates apostille at foreign origin, if any and other documents specified in clause 2.11.2 of RFP shall be submitted physically in original by the Lowest Bidder before issuance of Letter of Acceptance (LOA) by the Authority. However, while submitting Bid Security via Account Payee demand draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt or Banker's Cheque, it is to be ensured by the bidder that Account Payee demand draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt or Banker's Cheque are submitted physically latest within 5 working days of the Bid Due Date (upto 11:00 hours). Please note that the National Highways Authority of India reserves the right to accept or reject all or any of the BIDs without assigning any reason whatsoever.
